As with other first time authors, I too did not do a complete research, but only partially, since there's a lot of data to be read and it creates unnecessary confusion at the start (when I had the idea in my mind and had the content work in progress). I came to know later that there's no paperback printing in India through Amazon! Even the author copies are available to them on order based on the printing cost, but what hurts more is the shipping costs, for a \$15 List Price of the book, the shipping cost is about \$16-\$17, so total cost of the book for one copy of the paperback version to be received in India goes to about INR 2300!!!
